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ASA / UKCC Level 1 Certificate for Teaching Aquatics units 105-107

If you are interested in supporting the teaching programme in a learn to swim environment utilising the ASA National Plan for Teaching Swimming, this certificate is suitable for you. Achievement of this certificate will qualify you to operate as a support teacher. It will provide you with the generic “how to teach/coach” skills common to all disciplines together with specific focus on movement literacy. The second part of the course will focus on aquatic teaching including the technical knowledge and practical skills which will allow you to actively support a more senior qualified/licensed aquatic teacher at any level, in the delivery of a pre-prepared session. You will be expected to have an understanding of the aquatic environment and a basic understanding of appropriate corrections to common aquatic faults. Candidates must be at least 16 years of age at the start of the learning programme

Achievement of this certificate will qualify you to operate as a teacher. It will provide you with the generic “how to teach/coach” skills common to all disciplines together with a specific focus on Teaching Aquatics, covering a range of technical knowledge and practical skills that will allow you to plan, deliver and evaluate a series of consecutive sessions within the context of a self prepared scheme of work.

Candidates must be at least 17 years of age at the start of the course and must also have at least one of the following:

- ASA Level 1 Certificate for Teaching Aquatics
- ASA Level 1 Certificate for Teaching Swimming post 2002
- ASA Assistant Teacher Certificate (Swimming) post Sept 1994
- STA (Swimming Teachers Association) Certificate post Sept 1994
- Gained exemption prior to enrolment from the ASA

ASA/UKCC Level 2 Certificate for Coaching Swimming Units 205-208

If you are interested in the coaching programme in a competitive environment, this certificate is suitable for you. Achievement of this certificate will qualify you to operate as a coach. It will provide you with the generic “how to teach/ coach” skills common to all disciplines together with a specific focus on swimming coaching technical knowledge and practical skills that will allow you to plan, deliver and evaluate a series of six consecutive sessions within the context of a macro cycle prepared by a senior/licensed coach.

Candidates must be at least 17 years of age at the start of the course and must also have at least one of the following:

- You should hold the ASA Level 1 Certificate for Coaching Swimming
- Hold the ASA Level 1 Certificate for Teaching Swimming post 2002
- Hold the ASA Assistant Teacher Certificate (Swimming) post Sept 1994
- Have gained exemption prior to enrolment from the ASA
